Medium of Examination : English

Eligibility / Procedure :

- ❖ In objective type questions, for every **correct answer two marks** will be awarded and for every **wrong answer one mark will be reduced** from the total marks. **No mark** will be awarded for **unanswered questions**.

Note :

- ❖ Students should be present at the school premises before 9.30 a.m.
- ❖ No student will be allowed to appear for TSE without producing Hall Ticket.

Dress code :
